Deadline: Wednesday, March 12

L.A. Region Small Business Relief Fund. The County and City of Los Angeles and partners have launched the new L.A. Region Small Business Relief Fund to provide cash assistance grants for small businesses and nonprofits impacted by the windstorm and wildfires. Small businesses and nonprofits with revenue of up to \$6 million and less than 100 employees may be eligible to receive cash assistance grants from \$2,000 to \$25,000 depending on disaster impact.
